During the spring, the county paved Hillside Avenue north of Linda Drive. During the planning phase, it was decided to extend the paving job 400 ft. south of Linda Drive so the curve at that location could be later treated with a grip surface to reduce collisions. (The red road, as we have on East Allendale Avenue.)

This grip surface is scheduled to be applied **on or about August 18, 2014. Hillside Avenue will be closed to ALL TRAFFIC in the work area**, which runs roughly from 309 to 340 Hillside Avenue. Access to the roadway will not be allowed except for legitimate emergencies.

Once begun, the roadway is scheduled to be closed for 24 hours (6:00PM to 6:00PM). Weather will affect this time frame. Rain will require a delay of the closure so that the grip material may dry properly.

If you need to visit anyone inside the affected area, please make arrangements to park on a side street or in the high school lot while the roadway is closed.
