Jan. 29 – A West Maple Ave resident reported that unknown person(s) used her identity to obtain a Lowes credit card and attempted to obtain Nordstroms and Ann Taylor as well. The Lowes card was used to make purchases, however at the time of the report the amounts were not known. The Detective Bureau is investigating.

Jan. 30 – Officers stopped a 32 year-old Paramus man on East Allendale Avenue and while speaking with the driver they noticed the smell of marijuana in the vehicle. Investigating further, it was found that the driver was in possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia. The man was arrested and charged with possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia in addition to being issued motor vehicle complaints for driving an unregistered vehicle and possession of marijuana in a vehicle.

Feb. 3 – When a 21 year-old Allendale woman came to headquarters to retrieve her lost cell phone, it was discovered that there was a \$1,000 warrant for her arrest from the Hawthorne court. She was taken into custody while arrangements were made with Hawthorne police for them to pick her up. During this process, a family member of the woman's posted her bail. She was then given a court date and released.

Feb. 8 – A 27 year-old Allendale man was stopped for a traffic violation and while speaking with him the officer noticed that he appeared to have been drinking. Due to his condition he was asked to perform standardized field sobriety tests, which indicated he was intoxicated. He was brought to police headquarters where he was given the breath test. After being unable to perform the breath test the man was released to a family member with Motor vehicle summonses for DWI, Refusal to Submit to Breath testing, and Improper Backing of a Vehicle

Feb. 8 – Officers stopped a 25 year-old Allendale man for a traffic offense and after speaking with him discovered that there was a \$400 warrant for his arrest from the Westwood court. The man was brought to police headquarters where he was able to post the bail. Motor vehicle complaints were issued for the traffic offenses.

Feb. 8 – An Allendale woman reported that while she left her wallet unattended for a short time at a local business money was stolen from it. Approximately \$70 to \$140 in cash was reported missing. The Detective Bureau is investigating.

Feb. 12 – Officers were called to an Erol Court home to check a suspicious vehicle. Upon their arrival they found a car with two occupants. Both were checked, and one was found to have an outstanding warrant from Elmwood Park. The 42 year-old man was brought to police headquarters where his employer posted the \$100 bail for him.

Feb. 13 – While working a burglary detail officers observed a suspicious vehicle on a side street and stopped it. Inside were an 18 year-old Upper Saddle River woman and a 17 year-old juvenile. As the officers were talking to them it was discovered that they were in possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia. Both were brought to police headquarters where they were charged with possession of the marijuana, possession of the paraphernalia and a motor vehicle summons for possession of marijuana in a vehicle.
