On June 27, 2015 at 10:05am, Allendale Police received a 9-1-1 call reporting a person threatening co-workers with two (2) knives at a business on Pearl Court; a location within the Allendale Business Park. Officers Sean Hubbard and Dan Rosendahl were dispatched and upon arrival encountered the caller who escorted police to the rear loading dock of the building where the suspect was standing. He immediately began to menace the officers with the knives. After several minutes of talking to the man, officers were able to persuade him to throw down the knives, but he remained aggressive, continuing to threaten the officers. The officers continued their attempts to talk to the man, but he refused to comply with their directions. He was finally subdued after a brief struggle and was taken into custody.

The suspect, a 42 year-old man from East Orange was charged with Possession of a weapon/knives, Possession of a weapon for unlawful purposes, Terroristic Threats and Aggravated assault on a police officer. He is being held on \$25,000 bail.
