On Thursday September 29 at 9:10 am Officers Rizzo and Rosendahl were dispatched to investigate a suspicious vehicle in the Acme parking lot. A gray Ford Taurus was reported to be parked in the north end of the lot with a male sleeping in it. As the officers approached the Taurus they could see a man who appeared to be asleep sitting in the driver's seat. They also saw several wax folds of what they suspected was heroin on the passenger seat of the vehicle.

The officers knocked on the window and woke the man up. Once awake, he was asked to step out of the vehicle and was arrested. Officers found 7 full folds of heroin, 24 empty folds, syringes and open beer cans in the vehicle.

Elijah Grover of Norwich, NY was charged with Possession of Heroin, Possession of drugs in a motor vehicle and possession of an open container of alcohol in a motor vehicle. Bail was set at \$2,500, with 10% option available. Mr. Grover posted the \$250 bail and was released with an October court date.
