This is a message from the Borough of Allendale's Office of Emergency Management and the Allendale Police Department regarding the annual Holiday Observer's Fourth of July celebration this coming Tuesday July 4th 2017. In order to enhance safety, there are two important changes to this year's festivities.

- There will be a hard road closure after the show. No traffic will be allowed north bound or south bound on West Crescent Avenue until all residents are safely out of the park. Also, there will be no traffic allowed on West Allendale Avenue by the ball park.
- All bags, backpacks purses and other items are subject to inspection on the way into the park.

As always, motorists are advised to use extreme caution both before and after the event in and around the Crestwood Lake entrance. Always yield to pedestrians in crosswalks and comply with any Police Officers directions. Drive SLOWLY. Help keep our residents, our first responders and our emergency services volunteers' safe.

As always, NO glass containers are allowed into the park at any time.

The rain date for the Fourth of July Celebration is Saturday July 8th. Please do not call police headquarters for information. If the fireworks are rescheduled an additional swiftreach messages will be sent, the Borough's website, and the Borough's Facebook page will be updated.
